“In other words, we are responsible for what we attract into our lives,” she said.

This, she said, explained why a person might keep attracting partners with mismatching personalities — because the energy or vibrations were constantly focused on what he or she did not want (a negative vibration), instead of what was desired (a positive vibration).

“The good news is that this negativity can be reset into positive vibrations, thus changing the end result and getting more of what one wants, and less of what one does not — in this case, to attract an ideal partner or to improve one's current romantic relationship,” she added.

Lim guided the participants through a series of on-ground activities to check and reset their vibrations (feelings), and introduced them to three simple yet effective steps to help them deliberately attract their ideal love partner.
